Spring 1 - What goes on in our local area?



Maths- addition and subtraction of two digit numbers with and without crossing a ten, comparing number sentences, solving missing number problems.

English, -Exploring our new text, writing for different purposes including non-fiction and poetry, using past and present tense suffixes accurately, using conjunctions for sentence extension.

Phonics- Continuation of Phase 5. Embedding and applying phonic knowledge in our writing.

Geography- To explore human and physical features and use appropriate vocabulary, to describe them, to recognize human and physical features on maps.

Science- Explore the difference between things that are living, dead and have never been alive, name different habitats and the living things that live within them including microhabitats, explain why habitats are best suited for different living things, describe how animals obtain their food.

RSHE—Aim High: To be able to learn from experiences, recognizing and celebrating strengths and setting challenging goals.

PE- Outdoor: Invasion games

Music - Use sounds to achieve an effect and to create short musical patterns, note how music can be used to create different moods and effects.

Computing—using a computer as a tool to create rhythms and melodies before creating a composition.
