FOREST SCHOOL

We are hoping to be able to start running Forest school sessions again in the summer term for all of the classes. Due to staffing shortages it has not been possible to run the sessions before now but we are ever hopeful that moving forward, we will.

FOREST SCHOOL INCLUSION

Forest school inclusion is a completely different type of offer and is also available to all children that may need it at different points in their education. Last term, we trialled groups and approaches so that we could refine and adapt according to each groups needs.

The inclusion aspect of Forest school targets specific identified needs the child may have as they move forward in their education. For example, a child may lose confidence, suffer from low self-esteem, experience bereavement or be a young carer. These groups can offer a time and place to 'let go' and enjoy team building exercises with their friends. These sessions take place in the afternoon with Miss Blades.

The morning provision will now be used as an outside classroom in the hobbit hut to enable children to explore their ideas in a supported environment, outside in the fresh air. They will be supported by a TA and Miss Bown. The children will be selected by the class teacher.
