Maths

Place value is our main focus for this term, looking at numbers up to 1000. Later in the term, we will move on to addition and subtraction.

Science

Plants is our main focus this term, identifying and describing the function of different parts of a flowering plant, what plants need to grow, how water is transported through plants and the life cycle of a flowering plant.

English

Our Power of Reading text is 'The Green Ship'. We will encompass drama and role play, character & setting descriptions and letter writing.

RE

Our focus in RE this term will be different religions within our community and the wider world as well as looking at how religious festivals are celebrated.

Geography

We will use maps, globes and digital mapping to locate countries and use fieldwork to observe and draw human and physical features.

Art

Natural resources will be used to create artwork. We will also focus on sketching skills, how to use charcoal in various ways and thinking about how art makes us feel.

RSHE

This half-term we will look at the importance of sleep, simple hygiene routines, mental health and emotions, recognising feelings in others and the children's responsibility to keep themselves and others safe.
