To understand place value to 20, counting forwards and backwards, finding one more and one less, comparing and ordering numbers.

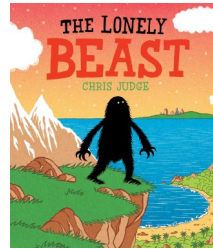
Identifying tens and ones in numbers up to 20. Representing and using number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. Adding one-digit numbers to 20, including 0.
