Our overarching theme: Festivals & celebrations



Our learning this half term:

This term we will be learning about Festivals and celebrations including Diwali, Firework night and the Christmas story.

Our whole class Phonics focus will be to learn the Phase 2 phonemes and begin to form them in our mark making. We will be doing lots of oral blending and segmenting of words, as well as providing lots of opportunities to write for a purpose.

In Maths we will be developing our understanding of numbers up to 5 by thinking about their representations and composition. We will continue to build on our subitising skills (knowing a number without having to count it's representation), as well as investigating circles, triangles, rectangles and squares.

In P.E the children will be developing their spatial awareness and gross motor skills. The children will have the opportunity to use the big outside garden daily to develop their core strength. They will also have lots of opportunities to develop their fine motor skills. We will also be practising and performing our Christmas production.

P.E lessons will be on Friday. Please ensure children come to school dressed in their PE kit and trainers. Our lessons will take place outdoors due to ongoing building work.

Phonic workbooks: Each Friday your child will bring home their Phonic workbook. This will contain an information sheet detailing the sounds the children have been learning that week. There will be opportunities to practise letter formation as well as read words. Please could the workbooks be returned on **Wednesday**.

- Regular reading 3x weekly. Please encourage your child to read their book more than once—this will develop their sight reading, pace & fluency.
- Look out for our weekly Maths updates on your child's portfolio. Board games are a really great way of practising the skill of subitising!
- Please support your child to complete their Phonics work book each week.
