Medium Term plan Year Four Spring 23

English: Informal and formal letters; persuasive language (tourist guides); non chronological reports; poetry; script writing; continuing to develop figurative language; revealing character through description and description of place, understanding persuasive language in advertising.

Grammar- clauses; adverbials; varying use of conjunctions.

Maths: To recall and use multiplication and division facts and begin to use these to explore factors. To write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the learnt multiplication tables , including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.

Science: States of matter: exploring the properties of solids, liquids and gases and what happens to the particles when they experience a change in state.

Art/DT: Investigate art, craft and design in different traditions. E.g. weaving, Anglo-Saxon & Viking runes.

Plan, design, make and adapt models weaving—Viking long boats

Use a variety of techniques including weaving.

Computing: To explores the concept of repetition in programming using the Scratch environment to develop both art and simple game development.

PE: Hockey: To work collaboratively. Passing skills moving towards a goal to maintain possession.

Gymnastics: pupils will explore ways to create more complex sequences

Music: Playing and composing music with the violin / flute
