Our learning this half term:

- Addition and subtraction of two digit numbers.

- Writing for different purposes

- To locate human and physical features on a map
- Explore living things and their habitats
- Explain how animals obtain their food
- Aiming high, learning from experiences and setting challenging goals
- Using sounds to achieve an effect
- Understand how music can be used to create different moods
- Use a computer to create rhythms and melodies
- Gymnastics sequences and routines
- Tactics for invasion games

Ongoing learning:

- Daily Phonics sessions
- Learning to read/write the Year 2 common exception words
- Guided reading
- Counting backwards and forwards
- Handwriting-letter formation and beginning to join

Key dates or things to remember:

Useful ways to support learning at home:

- Reading 3 times a week for 10 minutes. Remember reading is about comprehension as well as decoding skills. Ask your child thought provoking questions about what they are reading.
- Practise Numbots 3 times a week for 10 mins and spellings 2 times week (either using Spelling Shed or spelling book marks which will be sent home weekly)
- Look at Google Earth and maps together. Can you spot your house or our school?
